

CORE PRINCIPLES OF VOLUNTEERING

It is recommended that these core principles are adopted as the basis on which children's hospices would involve volunteers.

- 1. Volunteers are not free. Hospices require to allocate resources
- 2. Volunteers supplement staff and enhance the service
- 3. Volunteers need a meaningful and rewarding role with a reciprocal benefit to organisation
- 4. Volunteers must be effectively supported and managed
- 5. Volunteering is an integral part the hospice strategic plan
- 6. Volunteers must have opportunities for ongoing training and development, support and supervision
- 7. Volunteers can and should be involved at every level within the organisation
- 8. Volunteers are recognised as an integral and equal part of the team
- 9. Volunteers have equality of opportunity roles, expenses
- 10. Volunteers can expect to be listened to and heard and engaged in dialogue and ongoing communication with the hospice
- 11. Volunteers should be treated with dignity and respect
- 12. Volunteers should be valued, recognised and recognised

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
