Some of these conditions cause slow deterioration over time rendering the child increasingly dependent on parents and carers. Life-threatening conditions are those for which curative treatment may be feasible but can fail, such as cancer.</p> <p><b>Children and young people:</b> Babies, children and young people aged 0-25.</p>
