Family Factsheets



Short Breaks and Holidays

For many families caring for a child with complex disabilities or health needs it can be extremely difficult to contemplate being able to afford or organise a holiday with appropriate care in place. However, a short activity break for your child or a holiday together can be immensely rewarding and can enable your child and your family to build some special memories to treasure.

There are several charities which organise holidays for a seriously ill child, either with their family or on their own with a group of other children/ young people. These are provided in the UK or overseas, and different criteria may apply depending on the scheme.

For some, families can apply directly, whereas others may need a referral from a doctor or a recognised charity. Many of the schemes are open all year round and can be applied for online. These holidays are generally free of charge, fully insured and a medical team with carers is provided to ensure the child's medical needs are met during the holiday.
