I can confirm that we have now completed the search for the information requested, please see responses below:

NHS Frimley Integrated Care Board (ICB) was formed on 1 July 2022 under the Health and Social Care Act 2022, replacing NHS Frimley Clinical Commissioning Group (CCG). NHS Frimley is made up of five Places: (1) Bracknell Forest, (2) Royal Borough of Windsor and Maidenhead, (3) Slough, (4) North East Hampshire and Farnham and (5) Surrey Heath.

Please note that the legacy organisation NHS Frimley CCG existed between 1 April 2021 and 30 June 2022. NHS Frimley CCG was formed from the earlier merger of three legacy organisations – NHS East Berkshire CCG: NHS North East Hampshire and Farnham CCG and NHS Surrey Heath CCG.
