I write further to your e-mail of 2 May 2023 regarding information held by Suffolk and North East Essex Integrated Care Board. Your request has been dealt with in accordance with the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

In response to your request,

We only hold data for North East Essex and only for the last 2 months. This amounts to very small numbers which we would apply an exemption (section 40, see below). We have no data for Suffolk.

Section 40

Under section 40 (2) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000, a public authority does not have to provide information where that information is considered personal information under the Data Protection Act 2018. We believe that, because of the low number of patients involved and the potential for them to be identified when combined with other available information, the information you have requested falls into this category, and therefore will not be supplying this as a result. The actual figure has been replaced with <5.

"Life-limiting conditions are those for which there is no reasonable hope of cure and from which children will die. Some of these conditions cause slow deterioration over time rendering the child increasingly dependent on parents and carers.

Life-threatening conditions are those for which curative treatment may be feasible but can fail, such as cancer."
