If so, please attach a copy to your response to this request.</p> <p>Our Response:</p> <p>The CCG does not have a service specification for children with palliative care or end of life needs, however, they do utilise personal health budgets and also commission individual packages of care for those children with complex health needs.</p>


To request an internal review
